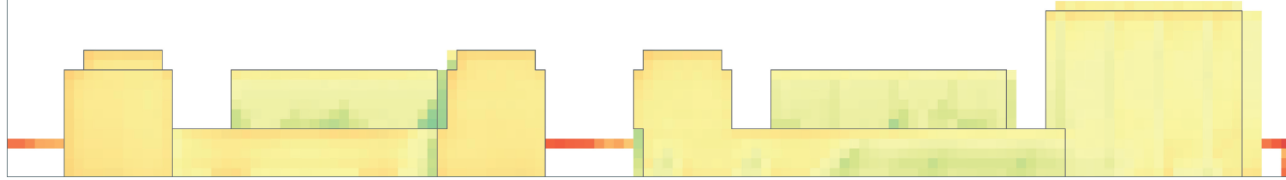
Solar radiation on facade

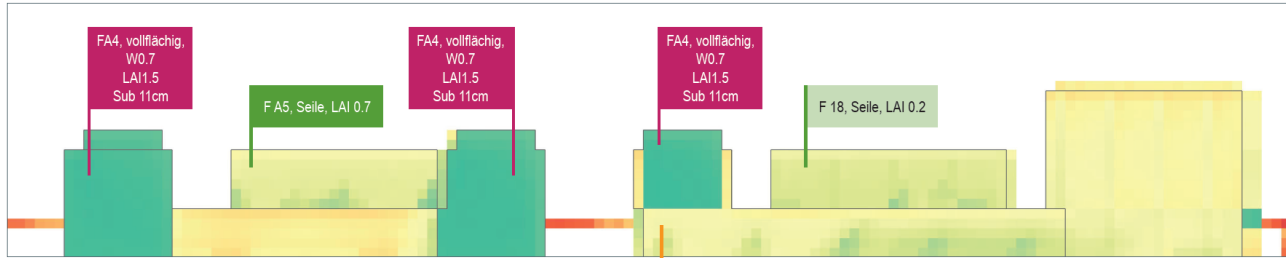
Façade temperature on 11th of June [24 hours average]

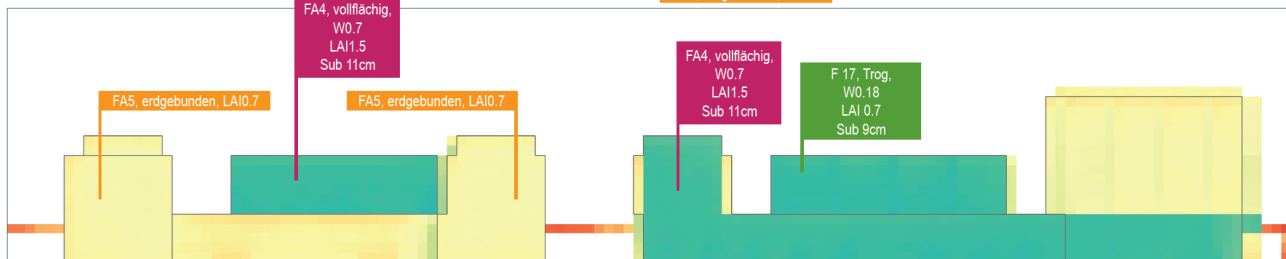

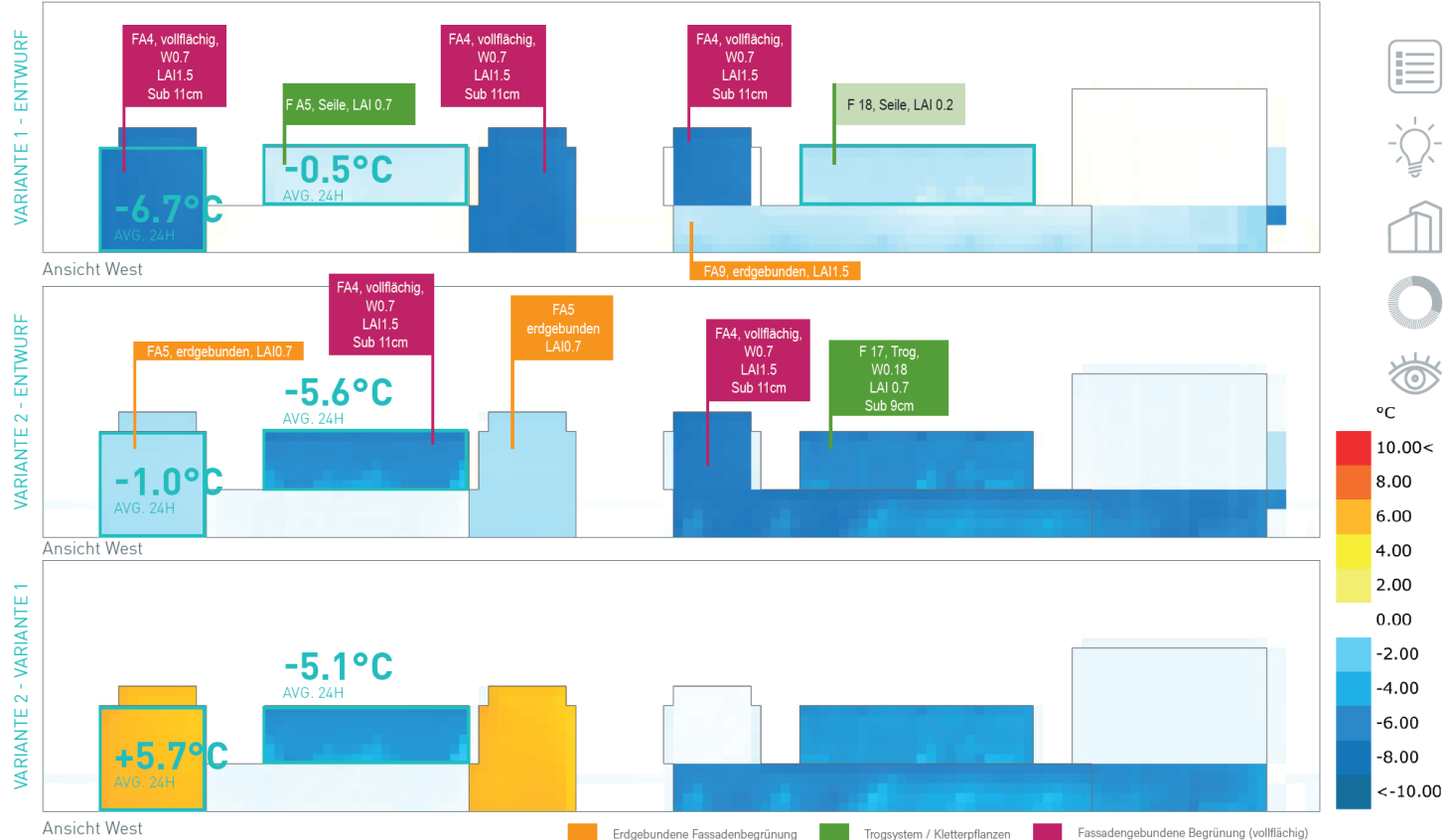

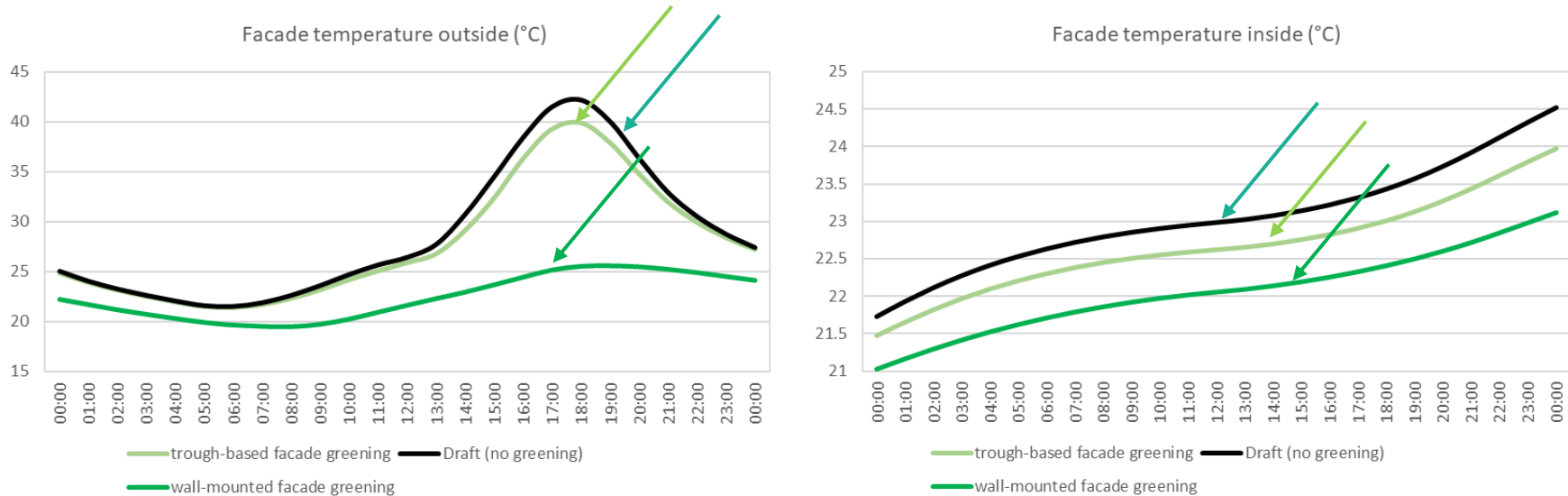

CONCLUSION



*Greening measures have a **compensatory effect** on outdoor microclimate and building surface temperature; Higher leaf-area index and thicker substrate layer increase effects*



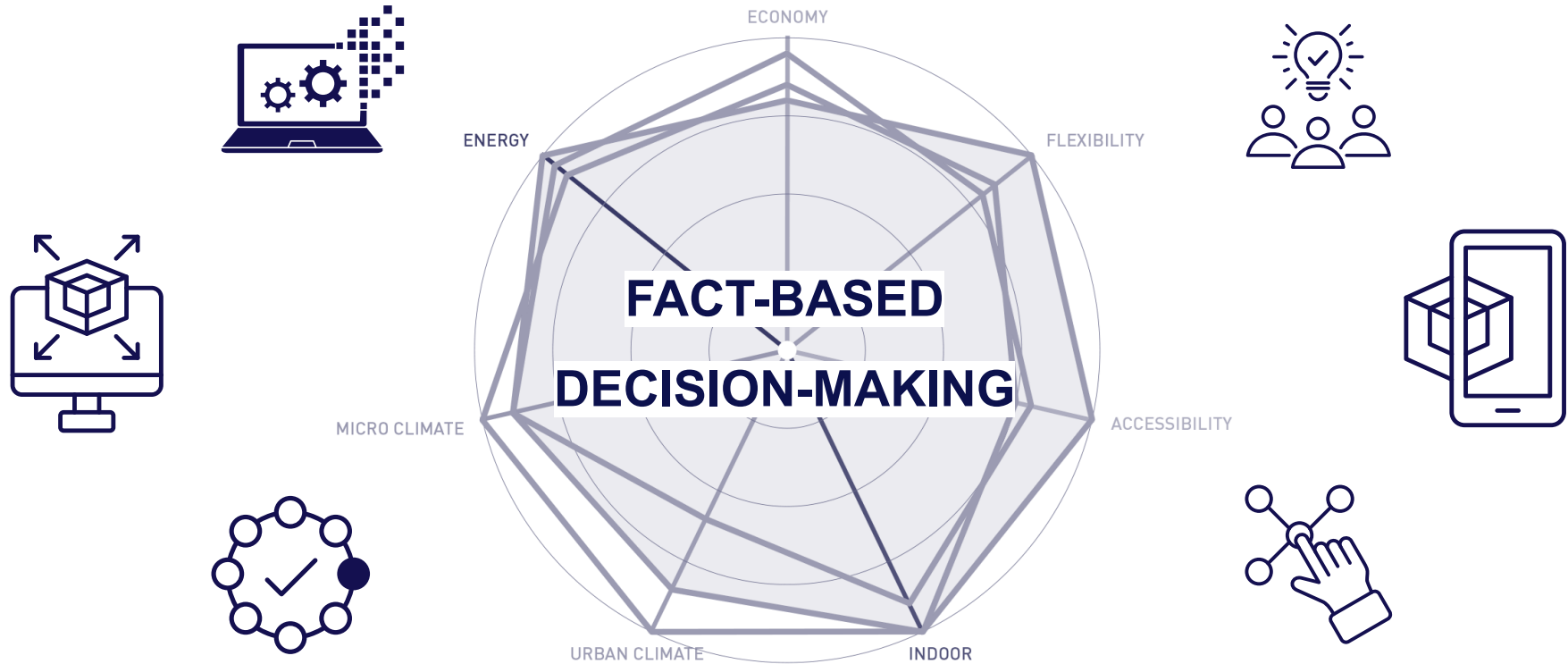
*Sound knowledge base: Need for **precise and site-specific information** showing effectiveness of greenery on microclimate, building envelope and indoor temperature.*



*Microclimate simulations can support decision-making, but require **thorough analyses of evaluation parameters** (which parameter, at what times, averaging methods, etc.)*



***Planning instruments and regulations** could be improved to force effective and efficient greening measures*



Adaptation to climate change



A microclimate simulation can show:

- Heat islands in a neighborhood
- Effects of different ground coverings, building geometries, or vegetation on temperatures
- Shading and ventilation effects → Contribution to DNSH: Proof that the project is planned to be climate-resilient and does not generate increased heat stress.

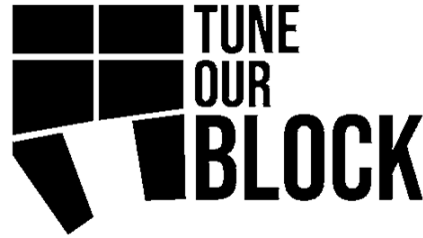


Why microclimate simulation facilitates DNSH-compliant planning

- It creates **transparency** about local climate and environmental impacts.
- It enables **early risk assessment**.
- It serves as **quantitative evidence** for approval authorities and EU taxonomy reporting.
- It **supports risk mitigation measures** (such as greening, unsealing, building strategies).

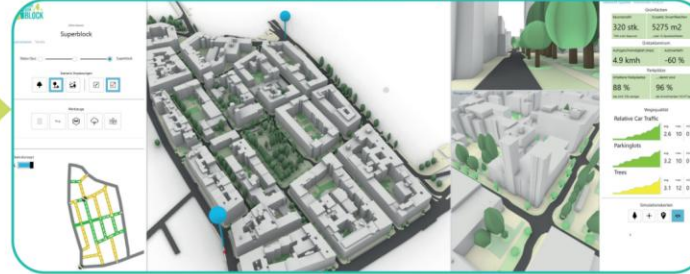

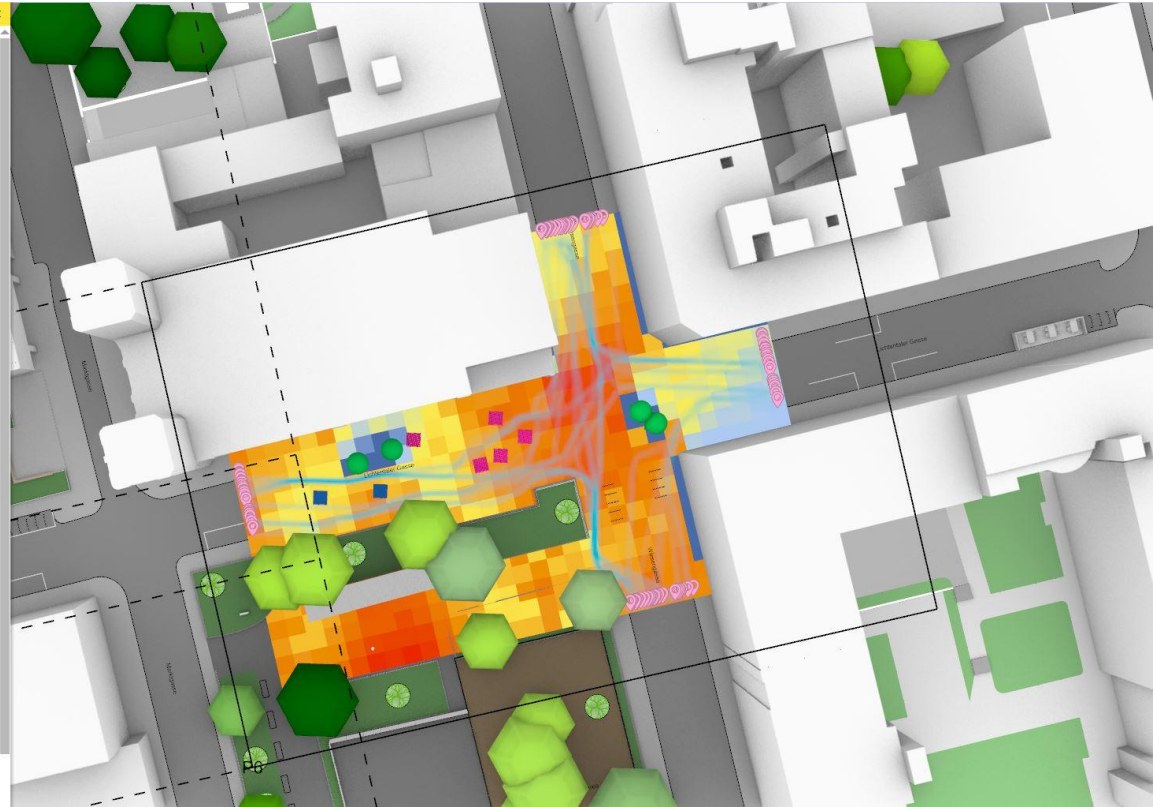
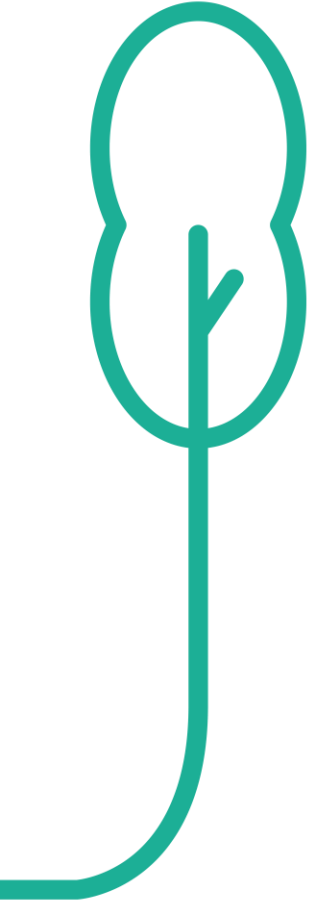

RESULTS



The first International Superblock Meeting was held in collaboration with the Barcelona City Council.



Planning workshops were held in collaboration with the Vienna Superblock Initiative in Lichtental, ideas were developed with local residents, and the effects were visualized (including using augmented reality).



City policymakers in Vienna are increasingly positive about the superblock concept. After a two-year pilot phase, a superblock is now being built.



During the project period, quality criteria for the implementation of superblocks were even defined in Berlin.

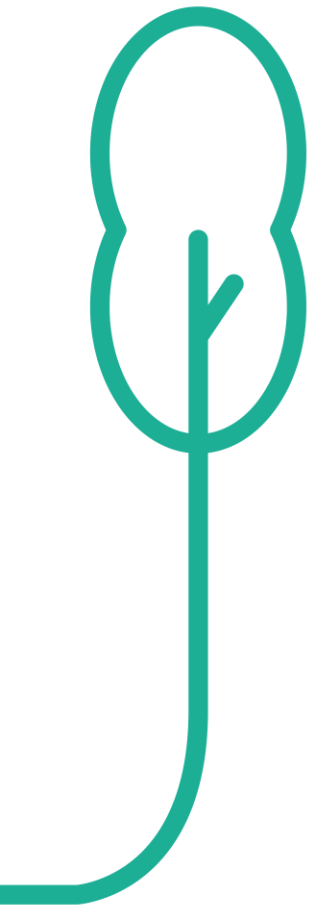

- 1st call of Innovative Actions – EUI
- Implementation: 1st of March 2024 – 30th of August 2027
- Total budget: 5.166.425,60 EUR
- Lead Partner – City of Varaždin
- Project partners: City of Ludbreg, FOI Varaždin, Croatian Forest Research Institute, Public Institution for the Management of Protected Nature Areas of Varazdin County, Turist Bord Varaždin, Kamnik Slovenia, Nyíregyháza Hungary, Commonwealth Sierra Espuña Spain
- Main objectives:
 - creative an innovative IT solution for managing and monitoring the city's green infrastructure
 - regeneration of the forest ecosystem
 - regeneration of forest infrastructure (paths, walkways,..)
 - connection of the city with the forest and creation of urban, functional core



CITY OF VARAŽDIN – Drava Park Forest

- Natural area protected in the category of park forest
- Part of Mura-Drava Regional Park and Natura 2000
- Exceptionally high biodiversity (over 180 plant and over 100 animal species)
- Location – north of the city, only 1.6 km from city centre
- the largest integral green area of the city

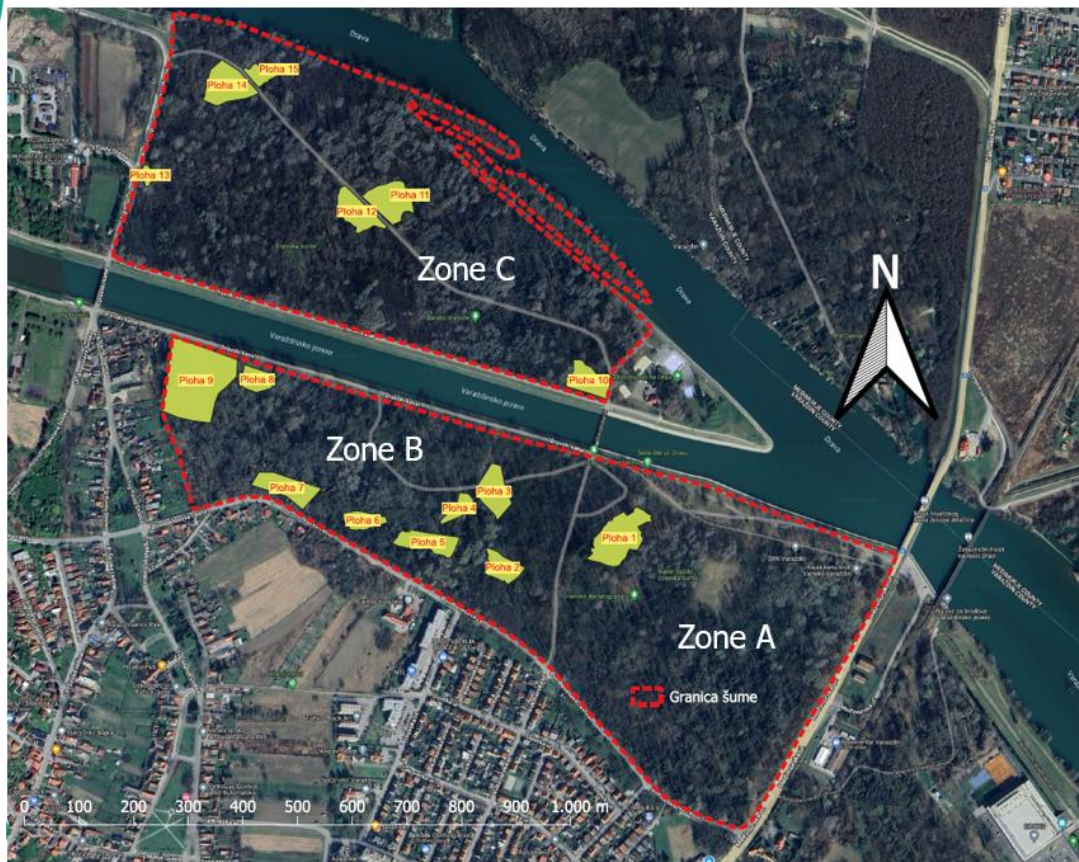
HEALTH ASSESSMENT AND FOREST REGENERATION

Expert Study „River Drava Forest Regeneration Programme”

- In order to restore the forest in the next 2 years → about 7% - 6 hectares of the total area of the Drava Forest Park has been identified

- The criteria for selecting the area for renovation were:
 - Health condition – drying of introduced coniferous species (mainly common spruce)
 - Predominance of shrub vegetation without a layer of trees
 - Abundant occurrence of invasive species in the ground layer
 - Absence or impossibility of natural regeneration in areas with predominant weeds

FOREST REGENERATION ACTIVITIES - LONG-TERM PLANNING AND MANAGEMENT

- The first step towards the regeneration has been started in July 2025
 - Croatian forests have marked trees that will need to be removed in the area of the 15 selected plots
 - The cutting is planned to start in October 2025, after the licence is acquired
 - The process of attaining the Licence for the planned works is undergoing

The European project "**TALEA - Green cells leading the Green transition**" was created with the aim of responding to the challenges and critical issues generated by the phenomenon of heat islands in the cities.

The approach combines technology, nature and citizen participation, we intend to experiment actions to make public spaces **climate refuges inclusive and accessible**.

Goals

Main objective

Contribute to reducing heatwave and heat island effects in the urban context and ensure lasting change at both the climate-environmental and socio-economic levels

Specific objective

- **Improve the adaptive capacity of the urban**, improving the possibilities for monitoring and analyzing urban administrations on the effects of UHI and their respective mitigation actions;
- Reconnecting **urban biodiversity**;
- Direct **influence on the urban microclimate**;
- Improve the **safety, well-being, and active participation of individuals**, with particular attention to vulnerable groups;
- **(Re)Activate new uses in underutilized urban spaces**, to connect and integrate them with broader resilience corridors.

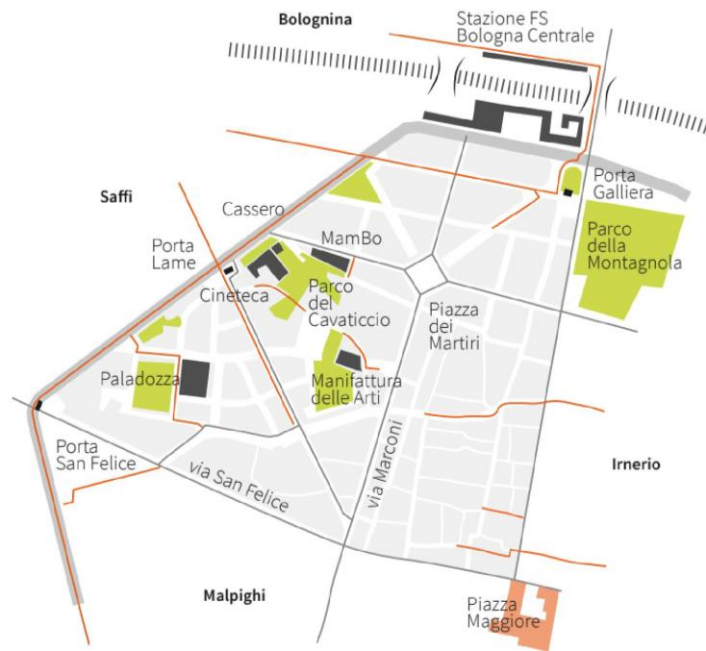
Highly adaptable and compact design space units (100x100 m) where to experiment with new nature-based solutions (NBS).

Depaving

Permeable materials, vegetal and mineral



It removes asphalt and concrete to make room for natural soil: this allows water to filter better and promotes greater biodiversity. Ideal for non-driveable areas of squares and streets.

Asphalt breaker: removes impermeable surfaces such as concrete or asphalt.

Sponge found: the water starts to infiltrate naturally again.

Green Shield: promotes nature, freshness and biodiversity in the city.

Permeable materials, vegetal and mineral



They reflect more light and absorb less heat than dark ones.

Smart light: They increase evening visibility and reflect more light, slightly reducing the surface temperature.

Thermo-shield: they reduce surface temperatures and the heat island effect.

Climbing plants bring nature where there is a lack of space, they cool and shade squares, streets and seats.

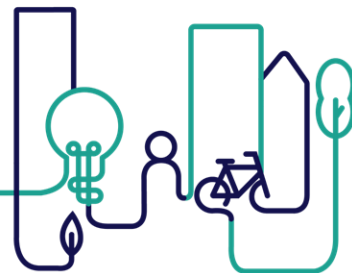

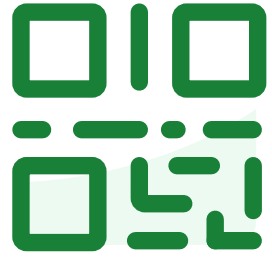
